All nominations will be destroyed following judges panel meeting.

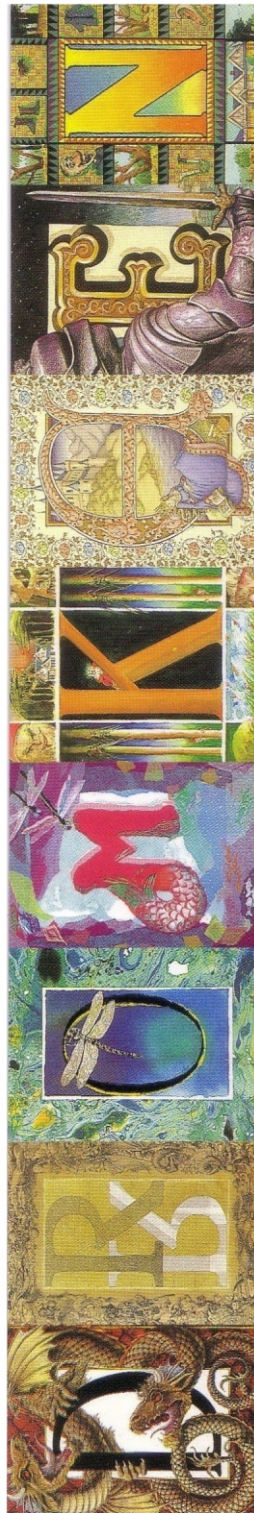
