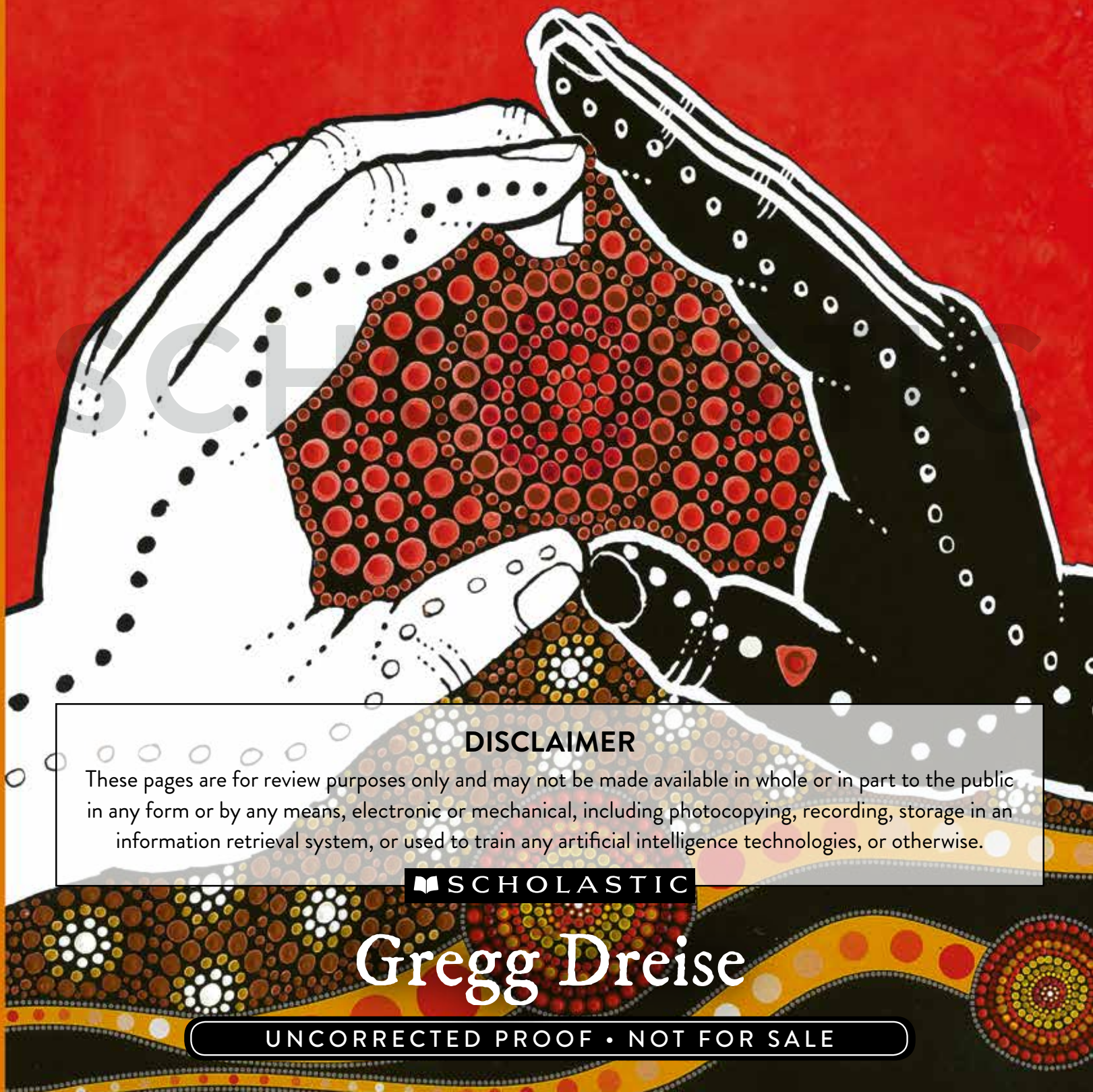

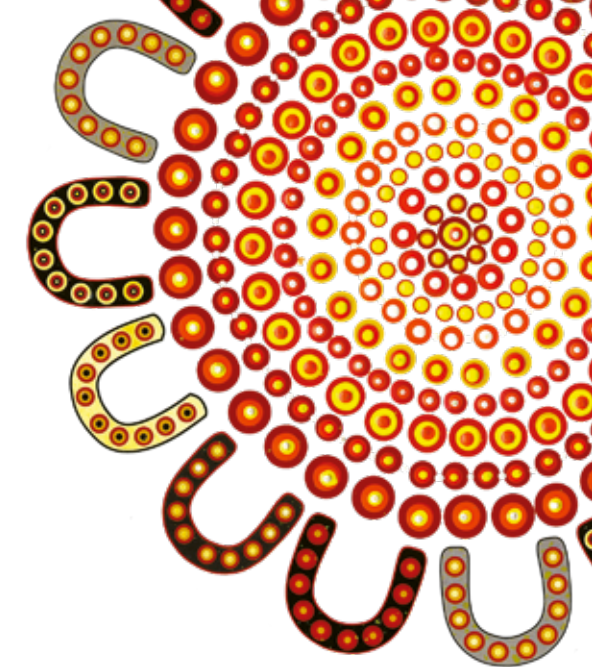

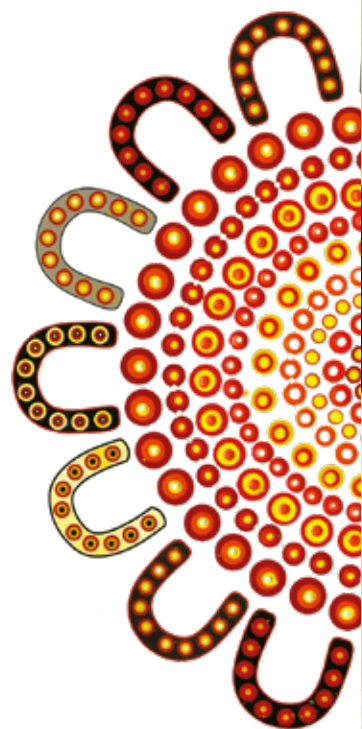

is what we should embrace.



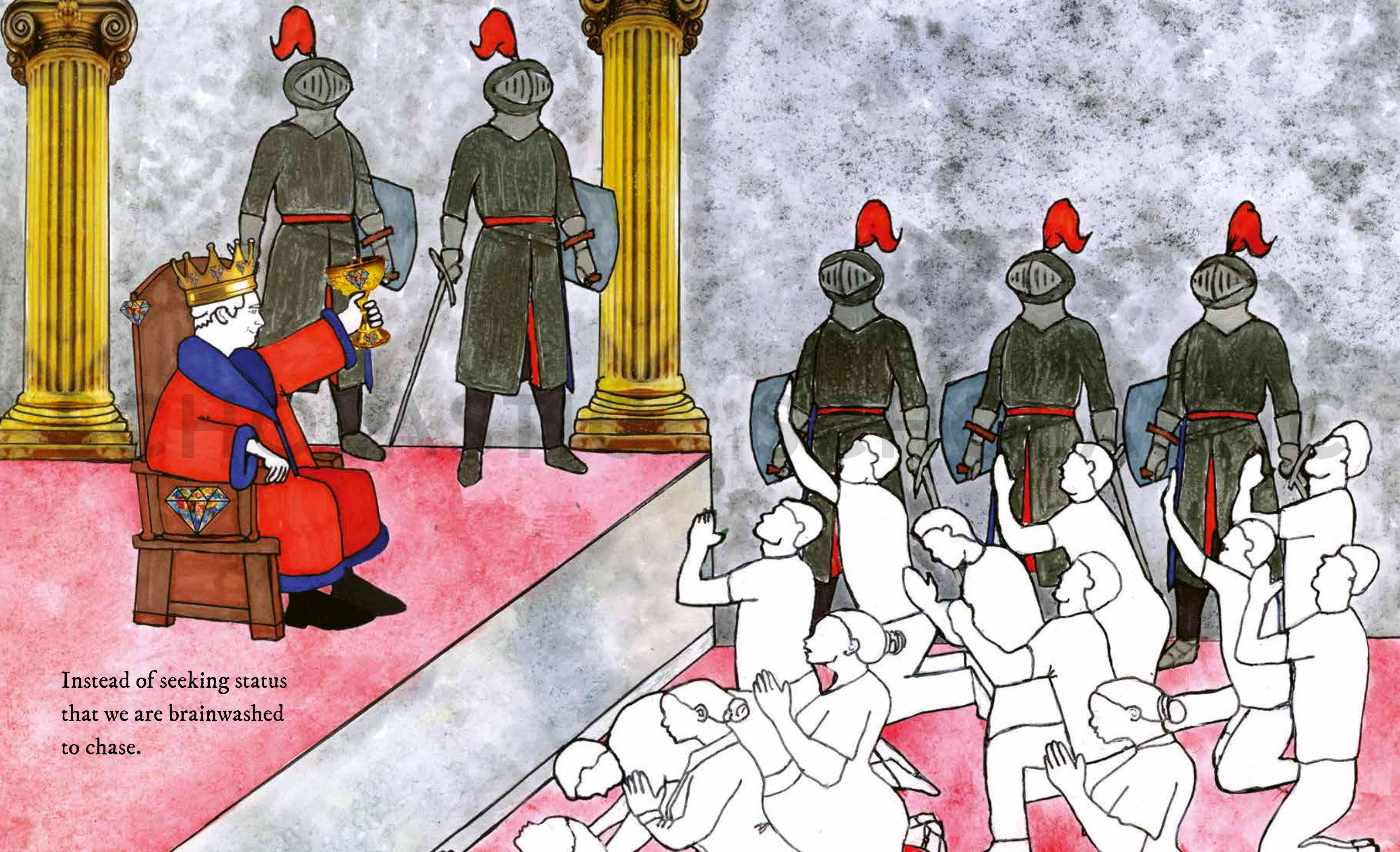
How can our humanity

it should be our solid base.



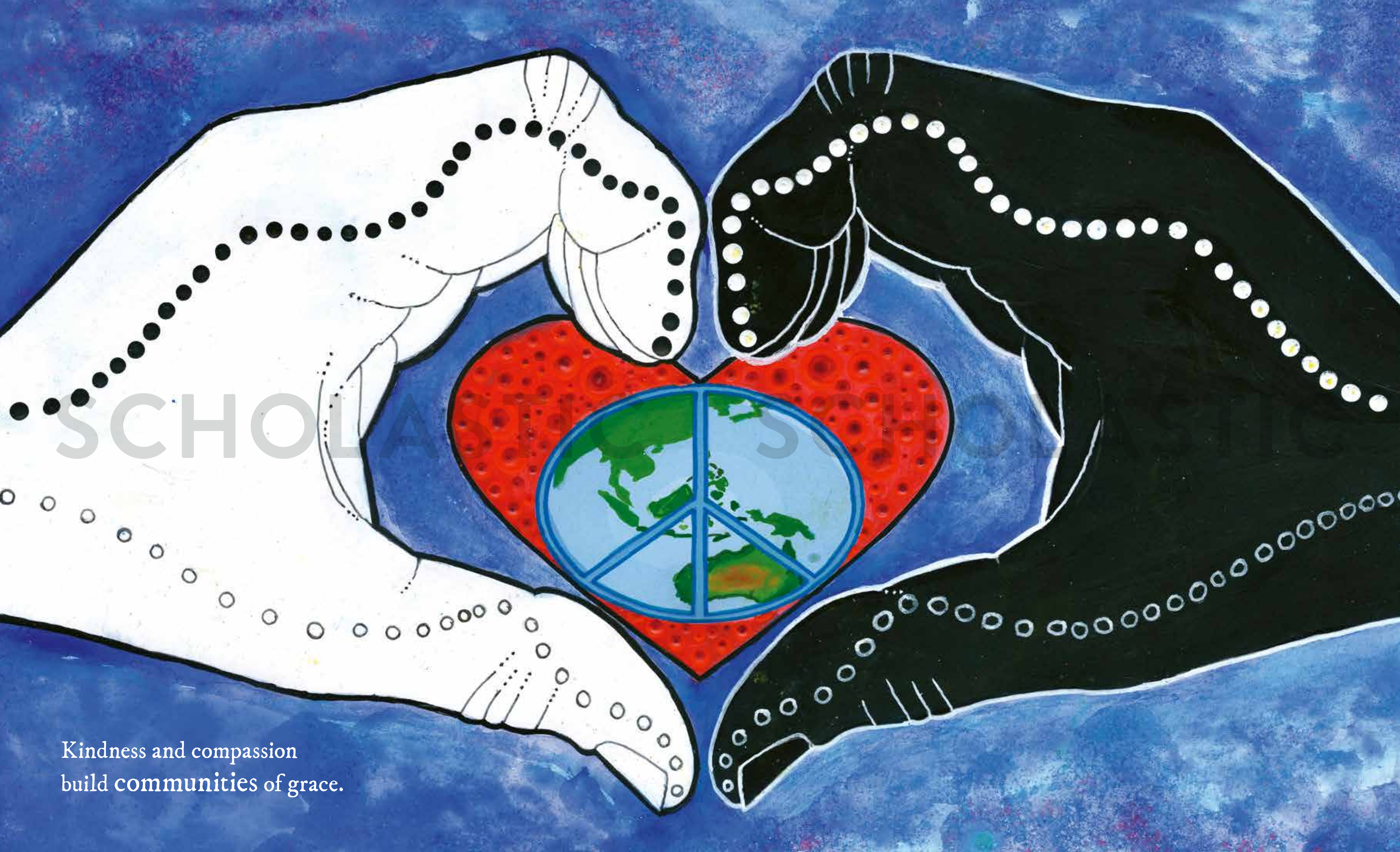

to chase.

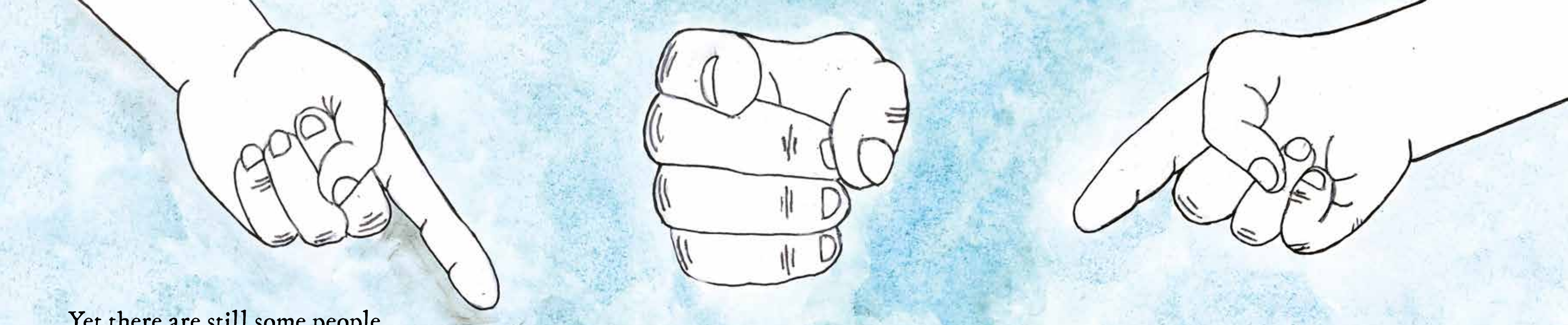

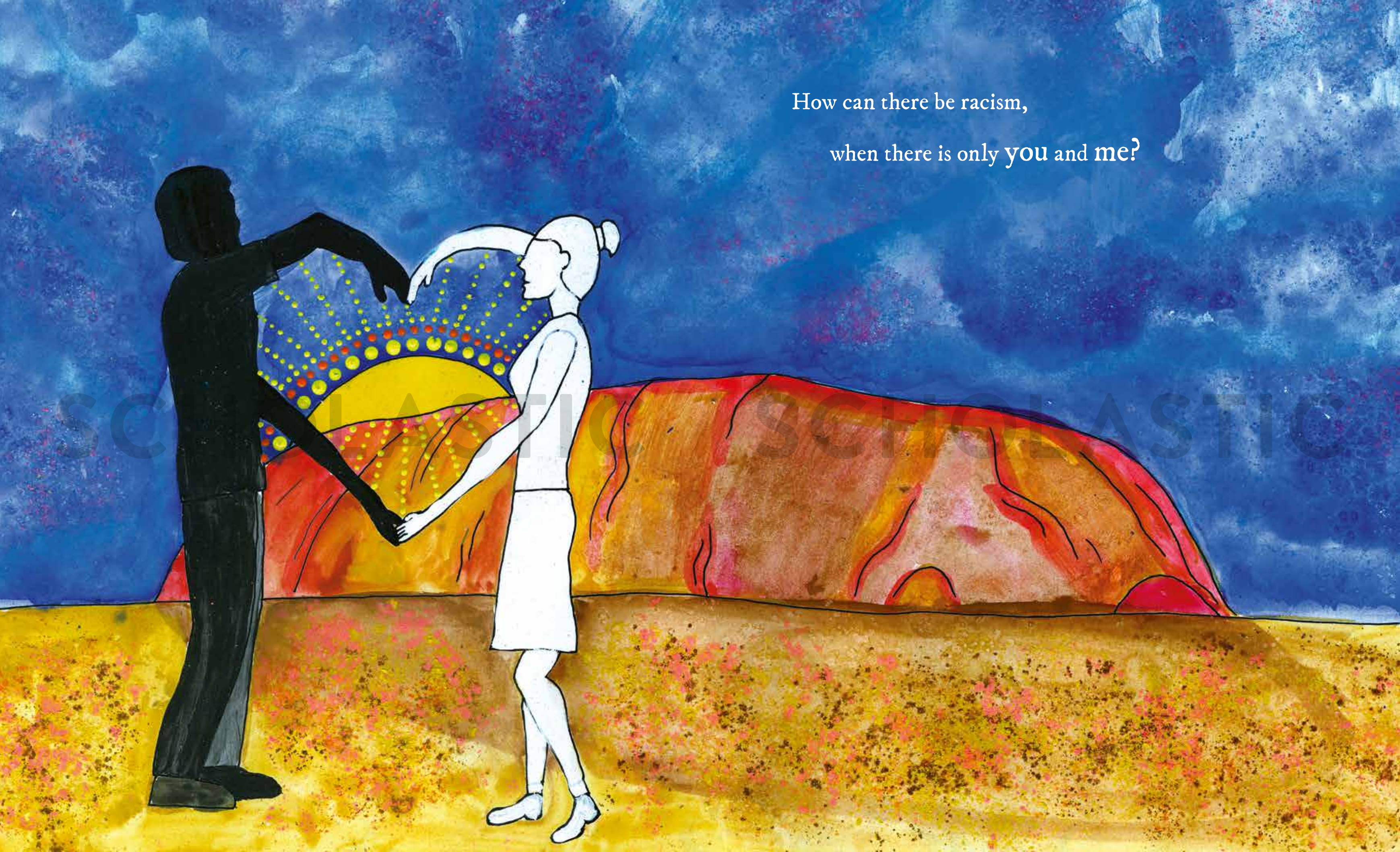
