

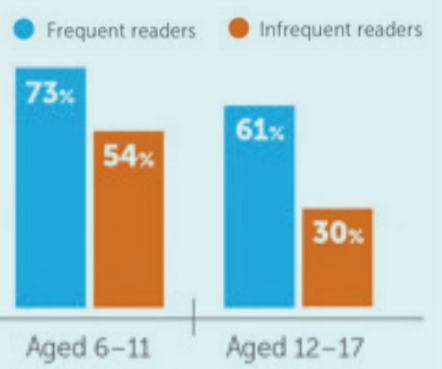


Motivate Children to Read More with Scholastic **Literacy Pro**

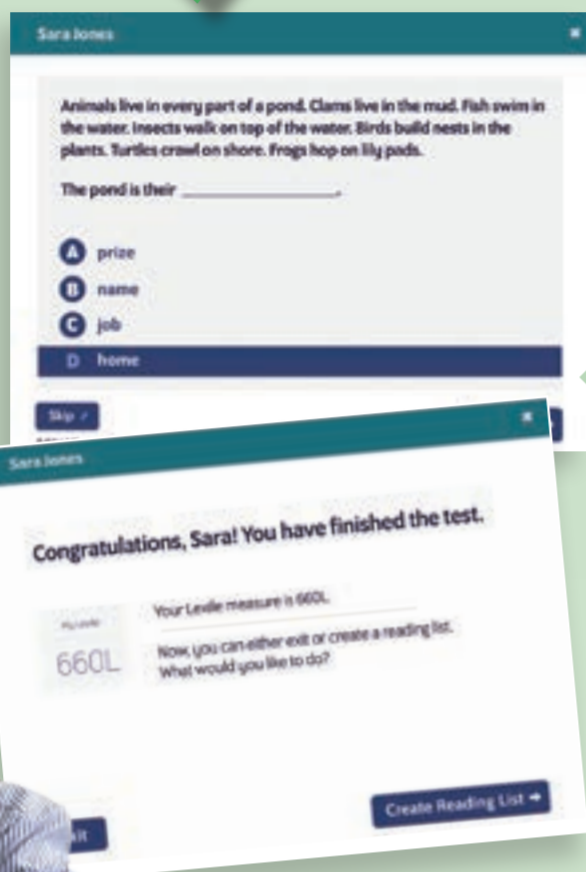
Students search online for a good fit book. They:

Scarborough State School set a goal of reading 50 million words in 2016. Through student motivation they surpassed this goal, reading 75 million words.

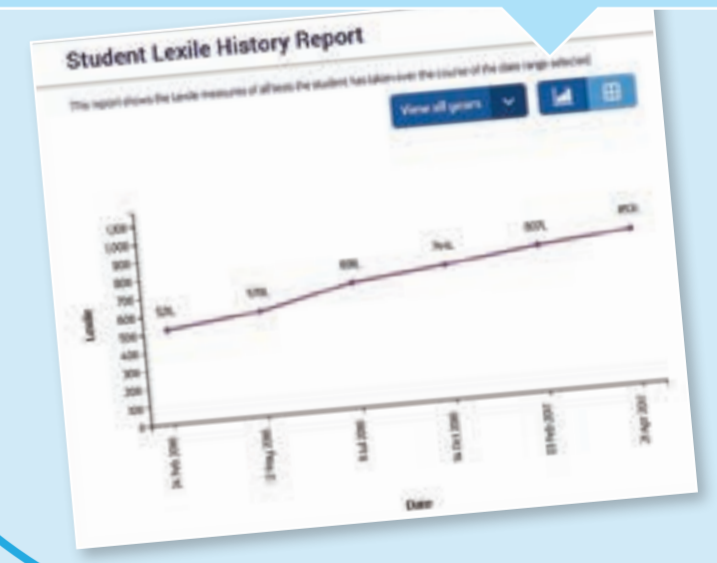

- Students**
- monitor reading progress
 - discover books that suit them as a reader, and
 - broaden their reading interests.
